

BYLAW 06/18

BEING A BYLAW OF FLAGSTAFF COUNTY, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, FOR THE PURPOSE OF CLOSING TO PUBLIC TRAFFIC AND DISPOSING OF PORTIONS OF A PUBLIC HIGHWAY IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 22 OF THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT ACT, CHAPTER M26.1, REVISED STATUTES OF ALBERTA 2000, AS AMENDED.

- WHEREAS** The lands hereafter described are no longer required for public travel; and
- WHEREAS** Application has been made to Council to have the highway closed; and
- WHEREAS** The Council of Flagstaff County deems it expedient to provide for a bylaw for the purpose of closing to public travel certain road, or portions thereof, situated in the said municipality, and therefore disposing of the same; and
- WHEREAS** Notice of the intention of Council to pass a bylaw has been given in accordance with Section 606 of the Municipal Government Act, and
- WHEREAS** Council was not petitioned for an opportunity to be heard by any person claiming to be prejudicially affected by the bylaw;




