Road Recovery

Crews will continue working on the following shoulder pulling project the week of June 14th:

- South of Daysland on Range Road 164, south from Township Road 444 to Township Road 442 for 2.0 miles.

Once this project has been completed, crews will be moving to the following shoulder pulling project:

- West of Heisler on Range Road 163, north from Township Road 430 to Township Road 440 for 6.0 miles.

Regular Council Meeting of June 9, 2021

CR-02-2021 Crushing Tender Results - Southwest Area

Council approved a motion to award tender CR-02-2021, for the supply, crush, and stockpiling of gravel for the Southwest Area of the County to McNabb Construction Ltd., in the amount of \$660,000 plus GST.

CR-01-2021 Crushing Tender Results - Mazure Pit

Council approved a motion to award tender CR-01-2021, for the crushing and stockpiling of gravel at the Mazure Pit to McNabb Construction Ltd., in the amount of \$143,000 plus GST.

MOST Funding - Heisler Senior Citizens Friendship Club

Council approved a motion to reallocate \$4,152 of Municipal Operating Support Transfer (MOST) funding from Flagstaff County's internal use to the Heisler Senior Citizens Friendship Club.

Flagstaff Informed Response Sharing Team (FIRST) - Galahad Long Term Care Temporary Closure

Council approved a motion to correspond with Alberta Health Services with our concerns about the long-term sustainability of the Galahad Long Term Care Centre and to engage in conversations and communication and to offer our support to seek solutions.
