### Road Recovery

Crews will begin working on the following shoulder pulling project the week of May 31st:

- **Northeast of Daysland on Range Road 153, south from Highway 26 to Township Road 464 for 2.0 miles**

## Council Highlights



### Regular Council Meeting of May 26, 2021

**Council Highlights** briefly identify decisions made by Council. Council encourages its residents, businesses and stakeholders to keep in touch with Council news.

#### **Revised Residential Dust Suppressant Policy**

Council approved revisions to Policy PW 013 Residential Dust Suppressant, as presented.

#### **Strategic Dust Suppressant Locations**

Council approved a motion that to minimize dust and reduce washboarding, MG 30, for the 2021 budget, be applied to the following locations:

- Township Road 440 from SH 870 to Highway 13 for approximately 2,550 metres
- Township Road 442 from the Town of Sedgewick to Range Road 122 for approximately 2,700 metres

At an annual approximate cost of \$30,000, to be funded in the 2021 budget through Operating Reserves — Public Works Projects.

#### **Support for the RCMP**

Council approved a motion to await the release of the Pricewaterhouse Coopers Canada independent assessment of a possible transition to an Alberta provincial police service, which was due April 30, 2021, and await the next steps undertaken by the Provincial Government in this matter before corresponding with the Minister of Justice and Solicitor General.

#### **Re-appointment of Returning Officer — 2021-05-26**

Council approved a motion to enter into a contract with Sandy Otto for the services of Returning Officer for the 2021 Municipal Election.

Council approved a motion that under section 13 (1) of the Local Authorities Election Act, Sandy Otto be appointed as Returning Officer.
