Gravel Crushing Tenders # CR-01-2021 and CR-02-2021

Flagstaff County is accepting tenders for two gravel crushing projects until 11:00:00 a.m. on Thursday, May 27th, 2021:

1. CR-01-2021 – Crushing & stockpiling of approximately 50,000 tonne of 4:20 modified spec. gravel and 10,000 tonne of screened 4:25 spec. gravel at the Mazure Pit (NE 16-43-09 W4M)
2. CR-02-2021 – Supply, crushing & stockpiling of approximately 40,000 tonne of 4:20. modified spec. gravel in the Southwest Area of Flagstaff County

Dust Suppressant

Crews will be continuing to spray strategic and residential locations with MG 30 dust suppressant. All MG 30 dust suppressant application is dependent on weather conditions.

Road Recovery

Crews will begin working on the following shoulder pulling project the week of May 17th:

- Northeast of Daysland on Range Road 153, south from Highway 26 to Township Road 464 for 2.0 miles

The Flagstaff County Agricultural Service Board will soon begin applying herbicides to municipal right-of-ways to control noxious weeds and brush. Please note that spraying does not occur 500 feet before and after a residence.

Residents who do not wish to have herbicides applied to roadside right-of-ways adjacent to their property this year must sign a "No Spray" Agreement and put up new signs prior to May 31, 2021. New

"No Spray" signs are available for pickup at the Flagstaff County office. Agreement forms are available at the Flagstaff County office or at www.flagstaff.ab.ca. "No Spray" Agreements transfer the responsibility for roadside weed and brush control from Flagstaff County to the landowner. "No Spray" Agreements are valid for 5 years.

Council Highlights



Regular Council Meeting of May 12, 2021

Council Highlights briefly identify decisions made by Council. Council encourages its residents, businesses and stakeholders to keep in touch with Council news.

Economic Development Week Proclamation

Council approved a motion to recognize May 9-15, 2021 as "Economic Development Week" in Flagstaff County and remind individuals of the importance of this community celebration which supports the expansion of career opportunities and improving quality of life.

Flagstaff County Grant Application to Western Economic Diversification

Council approved a motion to submit a grant application to Western Economic Diversification for \$150,000 to fund a feasibility study, business case, options analysis, and recommendations on the development of industrial sites with rail access in Flagstaff County and ask the Battle River Economic Opportunities Committee (BREOC) for a letter of support for the application.

2021 Weed and Pest Inspector Appointments

Council approved a motion to appoint Samantha Culbert, Sierra Freadrich, Mikayla Kuilboer and Matthew Pfeffer as Flagstaff County's Weed and Pest Inspectors for 2021, under Section 7(1) of the Weed Control Act and under Section 9(1) of the Agricultural Pests Act.

Review of Recreation Funding ICF Agreement Timelines

Council approved a motion to proceed with commencing the Intermunicipal Collaboration Framework (ICF) review regarding recreation funding prior to October 18th, 2021, municipal election.

Flagstaff Regional Emergency Services Society (FRESS) Resolution

Council approved a resolution for the formation of a society, as presented.

Ratepayer Request — Arterial Residential Dust Suppressant

Council approved a motion to provide residents on arterial roads, a 200-metre MG 30 dust suppressant, free of charge, at a maximum of two applications per year, at a total approximate cost of \$210,000 to be funded by Public Works Projects – Operating Reserves.
