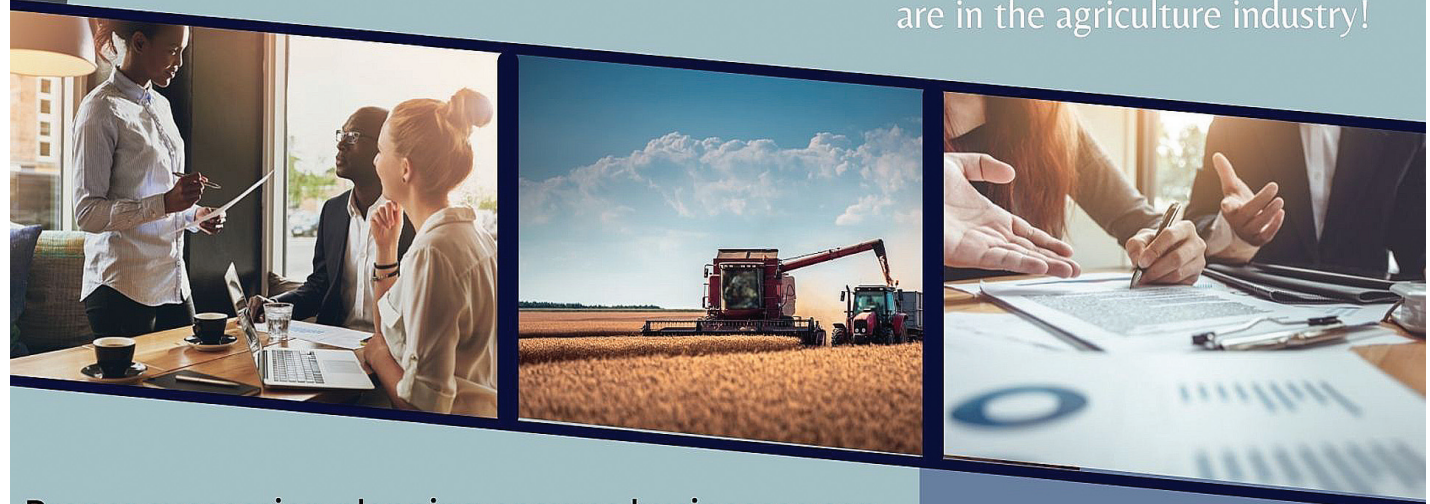

### Private Laneway Maintenance

Flagstaff County will once again be undertaking snow plowing on private laneways. Please contact the Public Works Department at 780-384-4100 for further details regarding this service. We will begin laneway inspections in November.

### Stockpiling

Crews will be stockpiling at the Daysland Stockpile Site, located south of Highway 13 on Range Road 170. Please use caution as gravel trucks will be turning onto and off of the highway.

### CCTV Inspection in Hamlets of Strome and Galahad

Please be advised that Flagstaff County will be undertaking a CCTV inspection of the sewer lines in Strome and Galahad starting Monday, November 1st.

### Winter Road Maintenance

Roadways are cleared of snow as necessary. During normal winter conditions, County gravel roads should be cleared of snow within four days, unless there is heavy snow and persistent winds. Back roads or blind roads will not be plowed unless deemed necessary by Public Works.
