#### Oath of Office

The Oath of Office was executed by each Councillor.

#### Election of Reeve

Council appointed Councillor Don Kroetch as Reeve of Flagstaff County for the 2021-2022 term. The Oath of Office was executed by Reeve Kroetch.

#### Election of Deputy Reeve

Council appointed Councillor Howard Shield as Deputy Reeve of Flagstaff County for the 2021-2022 term. The Oath of Office was executed by Deputy Reeve Shield.

#### Code of Ethics and Conduct and Values of Council

Council reaffirmed the Statement of Code of Ethics and Conduct and the Values of Council.

#### Election of ASB Chairperson

Council appointed Councillor Howard Shield as the Agricultural Service Board Chairperson for the 2021-2022 term.

#### Election of ASB Vice-Chairperson

Council appointed Councillor Jeff Eckstrand as the Agricultural Service Board Vice-Chairperson for the 2021-2022 term.

#### Policy Review

Council approved a motion that the following policies be approved as presented:

#### Axiom Oil and Gas Tax Payment Request

Council approved a motion to accept the proposal by Axiom Oil and Gas Inc. and offer a tax payment agreement to pay property tax payments of \$100,000 on or before October 29, 2021; \$100,000 on or before January 31, 2022; \$42,037.78 on or before February 28, 2022 and after full payment is received, waive a portion of the 12% penalty of \$17,044.51.

#### Request for Cancellation of Tax Penalty

Council approved a motion to respectfully deny the request for the cancellation of penalties levied on Rolls 388000, 387800, 387900, 388100, 388400, 390900 in the amount of \$437.56.
