Elections will be held for Councillor in Divisions 2 and 6 on Municipal Election Day. Elections will also be held for Senate nominee for the purposes of the *Alberta Senate Election Act*. Additionally, a vote of the electors will be held on the following referendum questions under the *Referendum Act*:

- Should Section 36(2) of the Constitution Act, 1982 — Parliament and the government of Canada's commitment to the principle of making equalization payments — be removed from the Constitution?
- Do you want Alberta to adopt year-round Daylight Saving Time, which is summer hours, eliminating the need to change our clocks twice a year?
