

# Regular Council Meeting of July 14, 2021

Council Highlights briefly identify decisions made by Council. Council encourages its residents, businesses and stakeholders to keep in touch with Council news.

#### **Purchase of 2022 Graders**

Council approved a motion to accept the quote received from Brandt Tractor for the purchase of one (1) 2022 John Deere 772GP AWD grader for the cash price of \$410,300 plus GST with a Guaranteed Trade-in value of \$190,000 after 5 years.

Council approved a motion to accept the quote received from Brandt Tractor for the purchase of one (1) 2022 John Deere 872GP AWD grader for the cash price of \$450,800 plus GST with a Guaranteed Trade-In value of \$190,000 after 7 years.

## **Drive-In Airshow Funding Request**

Council approved a motion to provide \$2,500 to support the Drive-In Airshow this July 24 and 25.

#### Forestburg Power Sports Association – Donation Request

Council approved a motion to provide Forestburg Power Sports Association approximately 200 yards of reject sand for their track at the former Forestburg Airport, with hauling not included.

## **Hardisty School Transportation**

Council approved a motion to not provide a letter of support to the Minister of Education – Supporting the concept of allowing school buses into the Hardisty community to transport students to the school of their choice.

## Flagstaff Scottish Club - Highland Festival Funding Request

Council approved a motion that Flagstaff County suggest the Flagstaff Scottish Club seek the County's recreation grant funding through the Flagstaff Region Agricultural Societies.

#### **Request for Cancellation of Tax Penalty**

Council approved a motion to respectfully deny the request for the cancellation of penalty levied on Roll 620000 in the amount of \$335.71.

## Killam and District Health Care Foundation – Seniors Tailored Living Project

Council approved a motion to support the Killam Health Care Centre and Covenant Health with their Seed Funding application to Canadian Housing and Mortgage Corporation (CMHC), to explore and plan for the development of the Seniors Tailored Living complex in Killam.

Council approved a motion that the Programs and Services Priorities be approved as presented for the 2022-2024 Business Plan and 2022 Budget.
