# Council Highlights



## Regular Council Meeting of August 24, 2022

**Council Highlights** briefly identify decisions made by Council. Council encourages its residents, businesses and stakeholders to keep in touch with Council news.

### Reserve Bid for Tax Sale Property 2022

Council approved that the reserve bid be set for the tax sale of the following parcel, with the terms for the sale to be cash, certified cheque or bank draft to be received within 48 hours of sale:

- Roll # 1003750 at RN67;3;35 to be set at \$27,000.

### APEX – Supplementary Pension Plan

Council approved that Flagstaff County become a participating employer in the APEX Supplementary Pension Plan with the class of employees eligible to participate being the Chief Administrative Officer and the Assistant Chief Administrative Officer.

### Rural Health Professions Action Plan (RhPAP) – Conference of October 4-6, 2022

Council approved that Don Kroetch, Chair and Allen Dietz, Vice-Chair of the Flagstaff Healthcare Attraction and Retention (FIHAR) Committee attend the RhPAP Rural Community Health Provider Attraction and Retention (A&R) Conference in October 2022 at an estimated cost of \$1,450.

### Agricultural Service Board (ASB)

Council approved the following items from the August 23, 2022 Agricultural Service Board meeting as presented:

1. To appoint Garret Jackson as a representative to the Battle River Watershed Alliance Land and Water Advisory Committee.
2. To participate in supporting an Alberta Community Partnership grant application to support the work under the Land and Water Advisory Committee.
3. To increase the annual funding contribution to the Battle River Research Group from \$10,000 to \$15,000.

### Flagstaff Community Adult Learning – Welcoming Community Project

Council approved that funding for the Flagstaff Community Adult Learning – Welcoming Community Project be considered during the 2023-2025 Business Plan and Budget process.

### Parents for Fun in Flagstaff

Council approved that funding for Parents for Fun in Flagstaff Society's Family Resource Centre be considered during the 2023-2025 Business Plan and Budget process.
