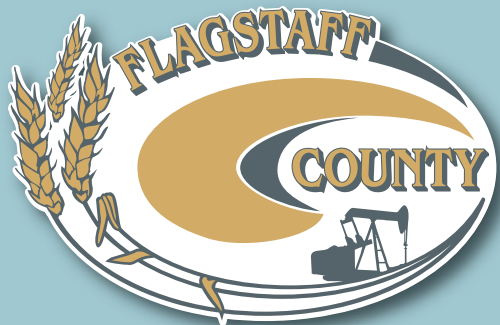

- Northeast of Alliance on Township Road 410 from Range Road 125 to Range Road 123 for 2.0 miles.
