Council accepted the quote received from Rocky Mountain Equipment for the purchase of one (1) 2022 Case TV450B Compact Tracked Loader in the amount of \$113,370 plus GST.

2022 Appointments under the Weed Control and Agricultural Pests Act

Council appointed Samantha Culbert, Matthew Edey, Maegen Kuilboer, Ben Hoyland, Amanda Culbert, Bernard Hagel, and Floyd Beausoleil as Flagstaff County's Weed and Pest Inspectors for 2022, under Section 9 (1) of the Agricultural Pests Act for 2022.

2022-2025 Strategic Plan

Council approved the 2022-2025 Flagstaff County Strategic Plan as presented, which includes:

1. Our Vision: To be a strong, vibrant, and sustainable regional Community of communities, contributing a rural essence and quality of life.
2. Our Principles: Council has defined three guiding principles that flow throughout all their priorities. These principles will become a part of all planning activities and considered in all operational decision making:
 - a. Collaboration – The County will endeavour to work collaboratively with the communities within Flagstaff County, their neighbours, local businesses, non-profit organizations and through provincial and federal programs in the delivery of programs and services.
 - b. Fiscal Leadership – Flagstaff County will balance the servicing and program needs of the community with consistent, prudent and transparent financial management.
 - c. Environmental Responsibility – The County will consider environmental impacts on all planning and development decisions and in the operations of their programs and services.

Public Input for 2023-2026 Strategic Plan

Council approved the draft Public Participation Plan for Public Input for the 2023-2026 Strategic Plan.

Flagstaff Kids Connection Daycare

Council approved that the County provide \$1,000 to the Flagstaff Kids Connection Daycare to assist with the additional costs incurred for upgrades to the new daycare facility.

Town of Sedgewick – Intermunicipal Recreation and Economic Development Representatives

Council appointed Reeve Don Kroetch and Clr. Jeff Eckstrand as representatives on the Intermunicipal Recreation and Economic Development (IRED) task force.
