ROADSIDE BRUSH & WEED CONTROL

The Flagstaff County Agricultural Service Board will soon begin applying herbicides to municipal right-of-ways to control noxious weeds and brush. Please note that spraying does not occur 500 feet before and after a residence.

Residents who do not wish to have herbicides applied to roadside right-of-ways adjacent to their property this year must sign a "No Spray" Agreement and put up new signs prior to June 1, 2022. New

"No Spray" signs are available for pickup at the Flagstaff County office. Agreement forms are available at the Flagstaff County office or at www.flagstaff.ab.ca. "No Spray" Agreements transfer the responsibility for roadside weed and brush control from Flagstaff County to the landowner. "No Spray" Agreements are valid for 5 years.
