Request to Lease SW 11-41-14 W4M

Council approved to allow soil testing and if the results are favourable, to enter into a three (3) year lease agreement for SW 11-41-14 W4M for 17.04-acres, with an annual lease fee of \$300.00.

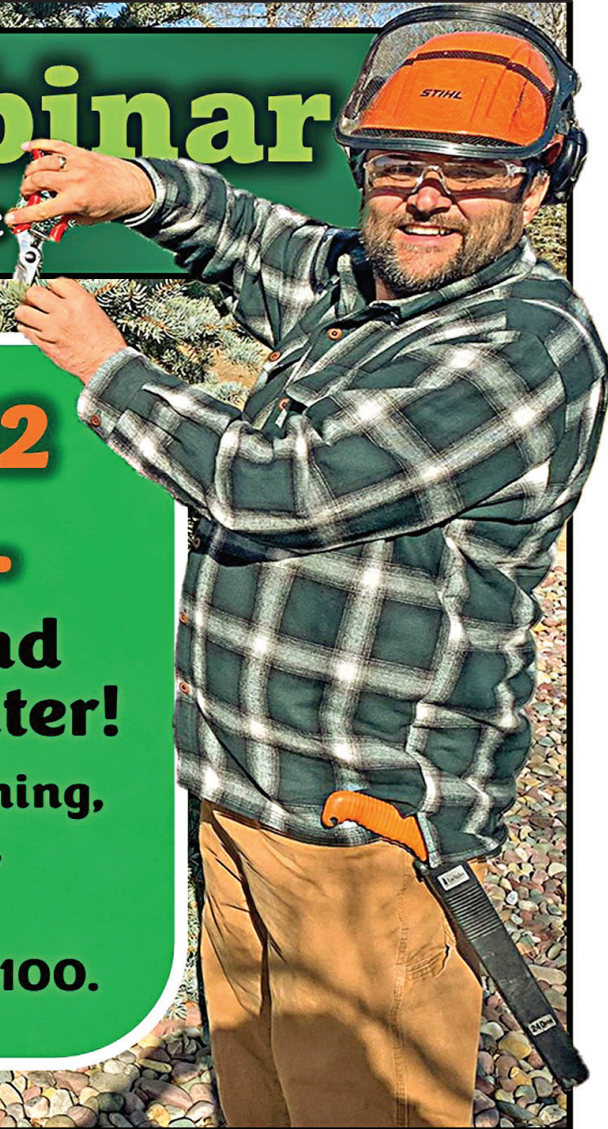
