Proposed Change to 2022 Recreation Grant Guidelines

Council approved the proposed change to the 2022 Recreation Grant Guidelines by adding: "The utilization of funds for the provision, upgrade, or maintenance of any alcohol-related portion within a facility is NOT permitted."

Cemeteries Assistance Grant Program Policy CP 009

Council approved revisions to Policy CP 009 Cemeteries Assistance Grant Program, as presented.

Bylaw 02-22 – Traffic Bylaw – Flashing Green Lights

Council approved Bylaw 02-22 – Traffic Bylaw, with the addition to allow responding firefighters to utilize flashing green lights.
