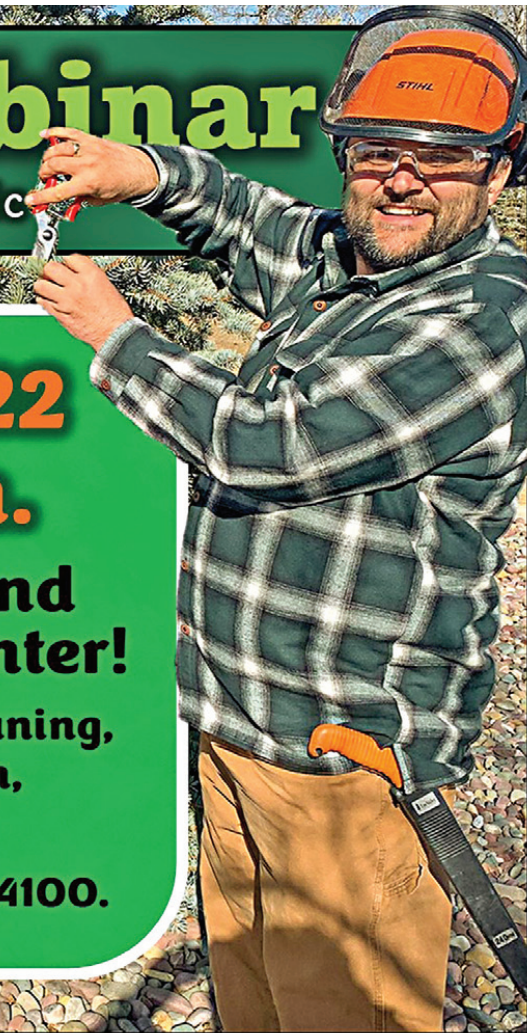

# Council Highlights



## Regular Council Meeting of September 28, 2022

**Council Highlights** briefly identify decisions made by Council. Council encourages its residents, businesses and stakeholders to keep in touch with Council news.

### Historical Information Database

Council approved to recommend to resident Charlotte Curtis that she consider establishing a not-for-profit historical society for the purpose of setting up and maintaining a historical information database for the collection of names, date of birth, date of death, and burial location from the Flagstaff area; and that once a society is formed, to request grant funding from Flagstaff County to assist with the initial setup of the database.

### Appointment of Auditor — 2023-2025

Council approved to proceed with requesting a quote for audit services from Gitzel & Company for 2023-2025.

### CP014 — Debt Management Policy

Council approved the new CP 014 Debt Management Policy as presented.

### 2023 Parkland Regional Library Budget

Council approved the proposed 2023 Parkland Regional Library budget of \$3,597,800 as presented, with a requisition of \$8.75 per capita.

### 2023 Flagstaff Regional Solid Waste Management Budget

Council approved that the proposed 2023 Flagstaff Regional Solid Waste Management budget with a total municipal requisition of \$1,340,000 (increase of \$48,311,16 or 3.74%) distributed to member municipalities utilizing the latest StatsCan Census Data (2021), and with Flagstaff County's total requisition being \$515,307.20, be deferred to the October 12, 2022 Council meeting.
