BYLAW 05/23

BEING A BYLAW OF FLAGSTAFF COUNTY IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, FOR THE PURPOSE OF REPEALING THE FOLLOWING BYLAWS:

WHEREAS

Pursuant to section 63 of the Municipal Government Act, R.S.A. 2000, Chapter M-26, a Council of a municipality may, by bylaw, revise any of its bylaws or any one or more provisions of them in accordance with this section. (2) A bylaw under this section may; (a) omit and provide for the repeal of a bylaw or a provision of a bylaw that is inoperative, obsolete, expired, spent or otherwise ineffective;

WHEREAS

Bylaw 01-10, duly passed by the Council of the Village of Galahad on May 18, 2010, to establish and enforce minimum standards relating to the state of maintenance of property and to regulate, control and abate nuisances and unsightly premises within the Village of Galahad, is no longer deemed necessary.

AND WHEREAS

Bylaw 743-07, duly passed by the Council of the Village of Strome on August 9, 2007, to regulate nuisances and unsightly and untidy premises, is no longer deemed necessary.

AND WHEREAS

Bylaw 747-07, duly passed by the Council of the Village of Strome, for the purpose of prohibiting, eliminating or abating noise, is no longer deemed necessary.

NOW THEREFORE

The Council of Flagstaff County, in the Province of Alberta, hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. Village of Galahad Bylaw 01-10 is hereby repealed.
- 2. Village of Strome Bylaws 743-07 and 747-07 are hereby repealed.
- 3. This Bylaw shall take effect as and from the third and final reading, and signature in accordance with Section 213(3) of the Municipal Government Act.
