Roadside Haying Permit Deadline Extended

Due to this year's prevailing dry conditions, our annual Roadside Haying Permit deadline has been extended.

Landowners have until **July 15, 2023**, to apply for a Roadside Haying Permit from Flagstaff County.

All landowners permitted to hay municipal right-of-ways must have their haying completed by **July 31** and must have bales removed within seven days of baling.

All permits are only valid for one year.
