Council Highlights



Regular Council Meeting of August 16, 2023

Council Highlights briefly identify decisions made by Council. Council encourages its residents, businesses and stakeholders to keep in touch with Council news.

Policy PW 010 — Residential Access Road Construction

Council approved to rescind Policy PW 010 – Residential Access Road Construction and not allow any residential development on Field Access and undeveloped road allowances.

Satellite Mulch Stockpile Sites

Council approved to develop a program, starting in 2024, for satellite wood chip storage sites where contractors can unload, and residents can pick up the wood chips.

Reserve Bids for tax Sale Properties

Council approved to set the reserve bids for the tax sale of the following parcels, with the terms for the sale to be cash, certified cheque or bank draft to be received within 48 hours of sale.

- Roll # 1007150 at RN67;6;27 to be set at \$58,000.
- Roll # 1004800 at RN67;4;23-25 to be set at \$189,000. (Taxes paid; removed from tax sale.)
- Roll # 1007100 at RN67;6;25, 26 to be set at \$200,000. (Taxes paid; removed from tax sale.)
- Roll # 1107500 at 4903MC;8;7 to be set at \$72,000. (Taxes paid; removed from tax sale.)
