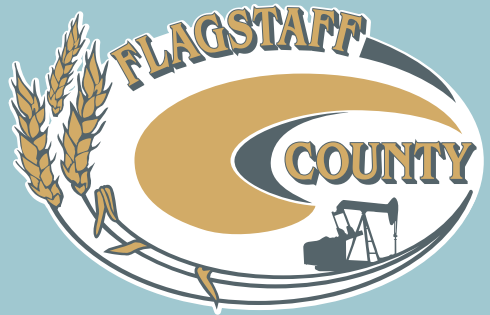

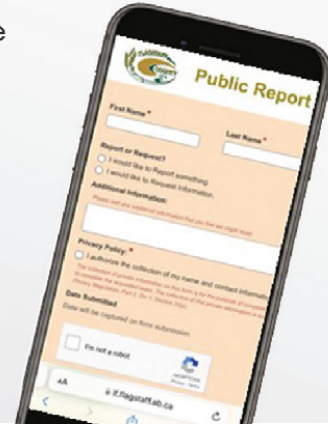

Regular Council Meeting of October 25, 2023

Town of Daysland — Request for Support of ACP Grant Submission

Council approved to support the Town of Daysland's submission of a 2023/24 Alberta Community Partnership grant application in support of the Regional Cemetery Asset Management Strategy project. The Town of Daysland will be the managing partner. There is no matching contribution required.

BREOC Formal Agreement

Council approved to recommend to the Battle River Economic Opportunities Committee (BREOC) that they form a sub-committee to draft a formal agreement with all members of the Battle River Economic Opportunities Committee, and that it be executed prior to December 31, 2023, with the agreement to include the following:

- Consideration of becoming a non-profit organization vs. having a managing partner;
- Current funding structure stipulated, including ownership of bank accounts, budget framework, etc.;
- Clearly defined roles and responsibilities for governance and management;
- Voting and organizational structure;
- Other relevant key clauses required.

2024 Flagstaff Family and Community Services

Council approved the 2024 Flagstaff Family and Community Services budget of \$496,432 with a commitment of \$9.50 per capita, with our portion being \$35,093.

Council appointed representatives to Committees and Boards for the 2023-2024 term. (The list is available on the website.)

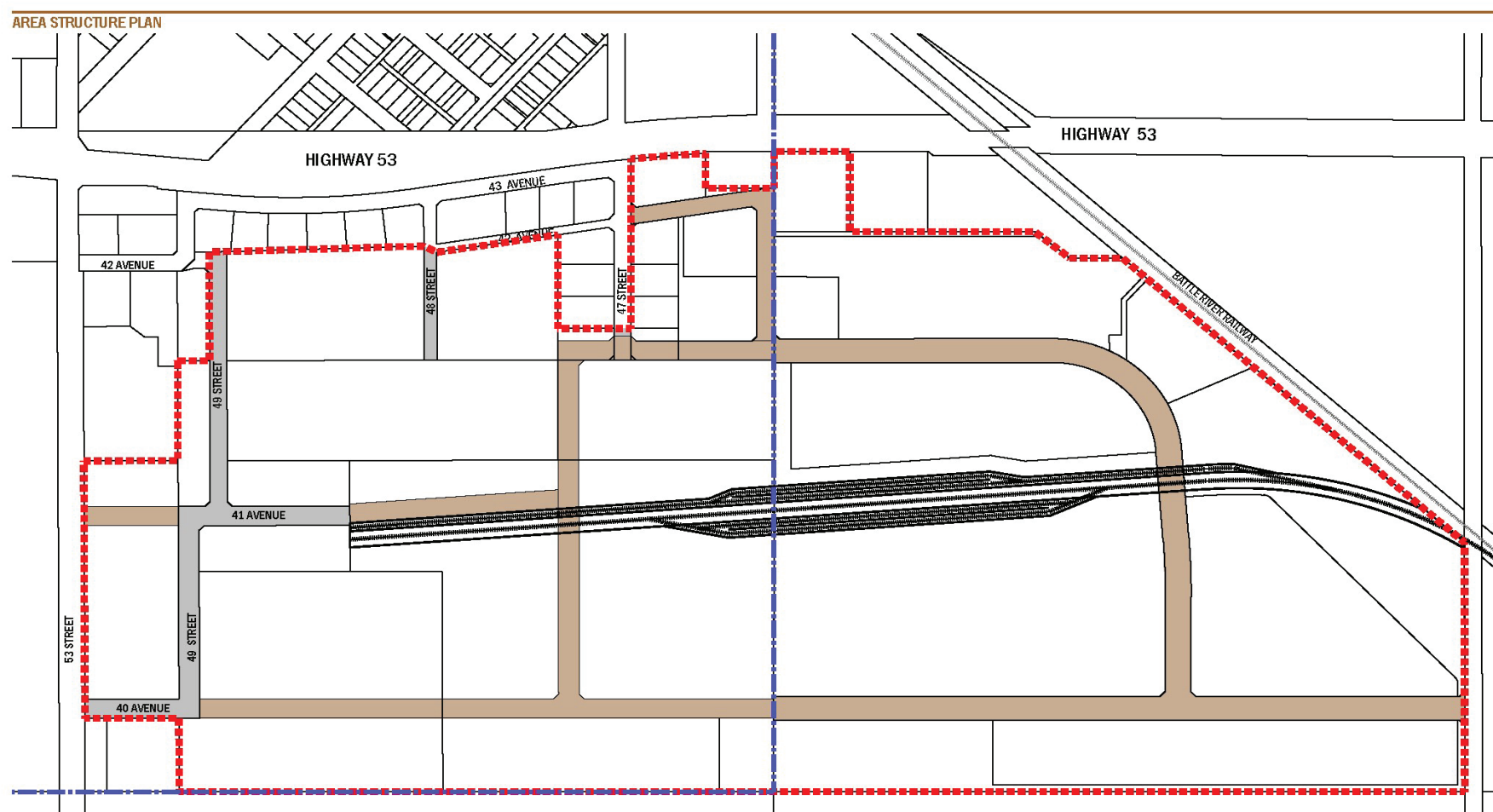
