Council Highlights



Regular Council Meeting of September 27, 2023

Council Highlights briefly identify decisions made by Council. Council encourages its residents, businesses and stakeholders to keep in touch with Council news.

Risk Assessment for Services Provided on Private Land

Council approved to continue the current practice of conducting an inspection/hazard assessment and obtaining the landowner's consent through an agreement prior to entering onto private land and commencing work, but not to require any further conditions. These agreements provide consent for the County to enter onto the private property as well include a hold harmless and indemnify clause ensuring that the County cannot be held liable for risks incurred from services provided. This process was reviewed as part of the County's risk management.

2023 Bridge Repair Tender

Council approved an increase to the 2023 Capital Bridge budget in the amount of \$175,000 for the repair of BF# 77982 and BF# 02408 to be funded by the Canadian Community Building Fund (CCBF). In August, MPA Engineering inspected 10 bridge structures and identified these two bridge structures as requiring high-priority repairs.

Policy PW 016 Road Classification and Level of Service

Council approved Policy PW 016 Road Classification and Level of Service, as presented. As part of the development of Flagstaff County's Asset Management Program, a new Road Classification and Level of Service Policy has been developed. The Road Network System is categorized and prioritized into road classifications. Each classification is described by criteria, road specifications and level of service. The descriptions provide clarification and ensure roads are designed, operated and maintained based on the service needs, the type of use and frequency of use.
