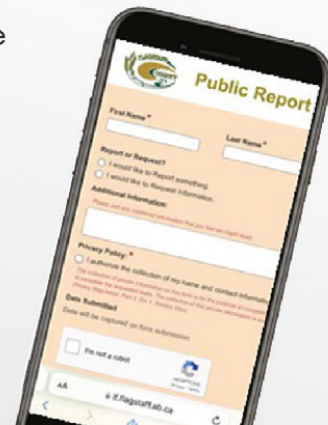

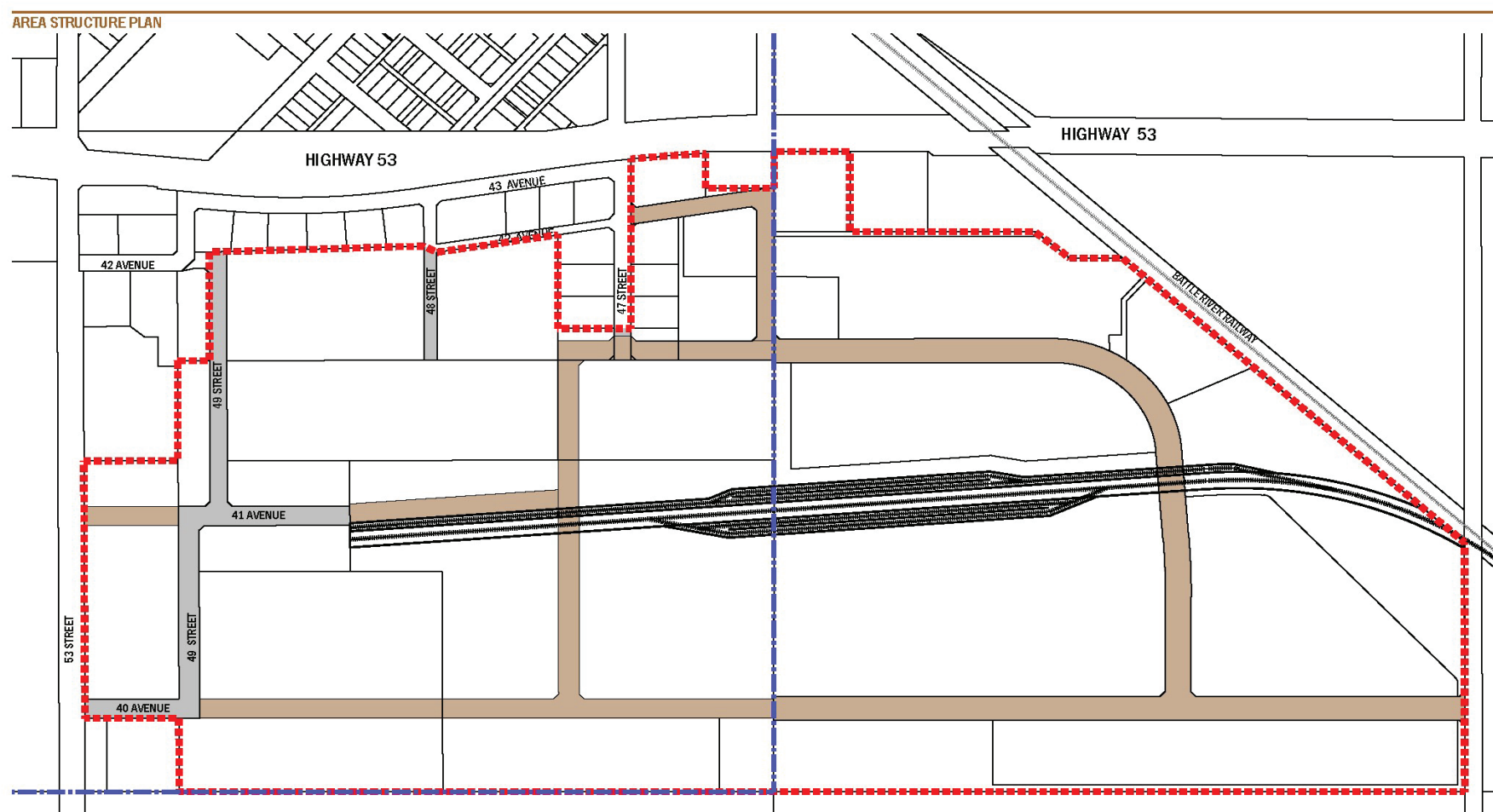




NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
