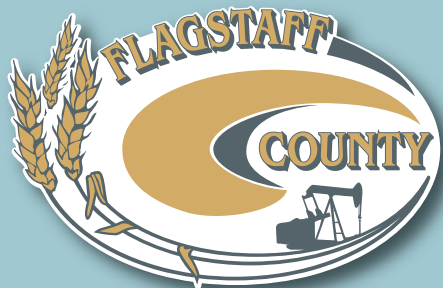

Regular Council Meeting of July 17, 2024

Council Highlights briefly identify decisions made by Council. Council encourages its residents, businesses and stakeholders to keep in touch with Council news.

Request for Quotation — Tractor

Council accepted the quote received from Battle River Implements Ltd. for the purchase of a 2024 John Deere 6155M Tractor in the amount of \$226,000 plus GST.

Washboard Complaint on Range Road 154 South of Highway 53

Council approved to inform a resident of the County's intent to monitor the washboard location and maintain Range Road 154 south of Highway 53 accordingly.

2024 Policy Update Review

Council approved 11 policies as presented. Policies are to be reviewed every three years, or sooner if they require revisions due to changes in programming or legislation.

New Policy CP 016 — Budget Management Policy

Council approved Policy CP 016 – Budget Management as presented.

2024 Tourism Assistance Grant — Parents for Fun in Flagstaff

Council, after reviewing the evaluation form for the grant request from the Parents for Fun in Flagstaff Society for the purpose of holding a Fitset Ninja Family Event, denied the grant request due to the application not meeting the requirements for the Tourism Grant policy criteria.

2024 Tourism Assistance Grant — Iron Creek Flying Club

Council, after reviewing the evaluation form for the grant request from the Iron Creek Flying Club for the purpose of holding a Royal Canadian Air Force F-18 Flyover Demo, approved the grant request in the amount of \$3,000 as well as in-kind marketing support from the Flagstaff County Economic Development Department.

2024 Brain Conference Donation

Council approved a \$500 donation in support of the Brain Conference being held in Camrose – October 25 and 26, 2024.

Corporate Services — Accounts Payable Clerk

Council approved the part-time (0.6 FTE) Accounts Payable Clerk position under Corporate Services as recommended.

Request for Cancellation of Penalty

Council approved to respectfully deny the request for the cancellation of the penalty levied on Roll 184410 in the amount of \$301.53.

Bylaw 07-24 to Cancel Subdivision Plan No. 9322480, Lot 1

Council approved Bylaw 07-24, a bylaw to cancel Subdivision Plan 9322480, Lot 1 (3.85 ac.).

Flagstaff Regional Housing Group

Council approved to forward a letter to the Flagstaff Regional Housing Group requesting a sustainability plan for the next ten years; and further, meet with the Minister of Seniors, Community and Social Services to discuss the future if sustainability is not achievable.
