# 2025 Shelterbelt Establishment Program

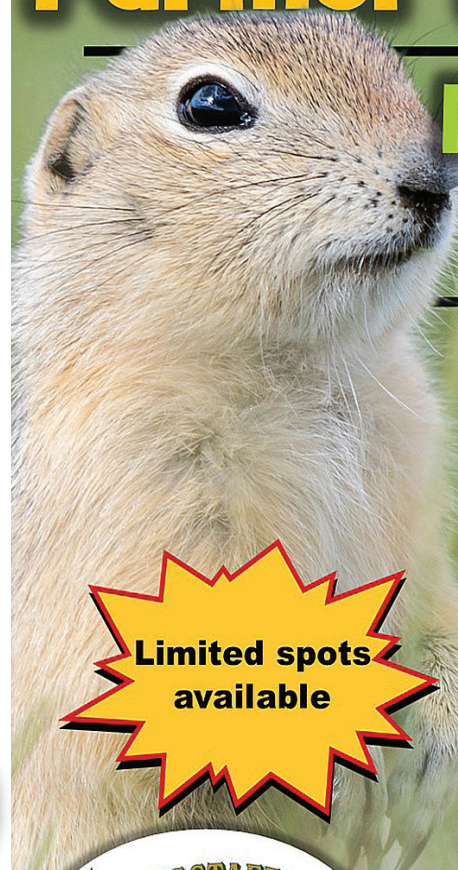
