- Responsible for ensuring compliance with Flagstaff County policies, the Healthy and Safety Program and the Human Resources guidelines and procedures.
- Assist with other duties and responsibilities that include shelterbelt, re-vegetation programs and additional assistance with maintenance of county lands as assigned from time to time by the Supervisor.
