Regular Council Meeting of August 19, 2026

Council Highlights briefly identify decisions made by Council. Council encourages its residents, businesses and stakeholders to keep in touch with Council news.

2026 Reserve Bids for Tax Sale Properties

Council approved setting the reserve bids for the tax sale of the following parcels, with the terms of the sale to be cash, certified cheque or bank draft to be received within 48 hours of sale:

- Roll # 21400 for SE-09-040-10-W4 - \$300,000
- Roll # 72100 for SW-12-043-10-W4 - \$775,000
- Roll # 1004800 for RN67;4;23-25 - \$162,000
- Roll # 1103000 for 3010BO;2;4 - \$9,300

Bylaw 06-26 Amending Land Use Bylaw 01-23

Council approved first reading of Bylaw 06/26 to amend Land Use Bylaw 01/23 by redesignating Plan 6080CH, Block 5, Lot 10 from Hamlet General (HG) to Hamlet Industrial (HI), and directing Administration to proceed with the required public notification and schedule a Public Hearing in accordance with the Municipal Government Act.

Xplore Inc. Request for Support

Council authorized administration to provide a letter of support to Xplore Inc. for its proposed broadband infrastructure upgrade project under the CRTC Broadband Fund Fourth Call for Applications.

Administration Building — Boiler System Repairs

Council approved funding in the amount of \$15,940 plus GST for the required mechanical system repairs at the Administration Building, to be funded from the Administration Operating reserves.

BF80998 — Vitae Request to Waive Site Occupancy Charges

Council waived the \$4,500 site occupancy charge assessed to Vitae Environmental for exceeding the 14 days bid for site occupancy days for BF# 80998 by three days, conditional upon Vitae Environmental waiving any early completion bonus for BF# 78061.

2026 Flagstaff Regional Airport Pavement Rehabilitation

Council approved proceeding with detailed design and preparation of tender documents for the Flagstaff Regional Airport Pavement Rehabilitation Project in 2026 at an estimated cost of \$50,000, to be funded from MSI Capital Grant funding, while deferring construction and reapplying for Community Airport Program (CAP) funding in 2027.

Jeanne Lougheed Historic Park Society

Council advised the Jeanne Lougheed Historic Park Society that, should Council approve the proposed expansion of the Tourism Assistance Grant Program to include Arts and Culture as part of the 2027 budget and policy approval process, the Society may be eligible to apply for funding under the program.

Camrose County — Intermunicipal Collaboration Framework (ICF)

Council approved that pursuant to the Municipal Government Act, Section 708.28, Flagstaff County determines and agrees that intermunicipal services with Camrose County have been and will continue to be adequately provided by means other than an Intermunicipal Collaboration Framework (ICF), and that they opt out of and conclude the Intermunicipal Collaboration Framework approved by resolution February 12, 2020.

Dr. Tim Hanton — Killam Medical Practice

Council received Dr. Tim Hanton's letter as information, recognizing that Council, at the July 8, 2026 Council meeting, approved participation in the committee established by the Town of Killam to explore the needs and possible development of a new medical clinic, and direct the County representatives to consider the requests outlined in the letter as part of the committee's work. Any recommendations involving County land, buildings, funding or ownership arrangements would be brought back to Council for future consideration.

Intermunicipal Assessment Review Board — Appointment of Chairman

Council appointed Howard Shield as Chairman of the Intermunicipal Composite Assessment Review Board (CARB), and the Intermunicipal Local Assessment Review Board (LARB) for a one-year term, expiring July 20, 2027.

Town of Coronation — Letter of Support for Highway 872

Council approved to provide a letter of support to the Town of Coronation regarding their request to Alberta Transportation and Economic Corridors on the condition of Highway 872, immediately north of the Battle River Crossing.

Brain Conference 2026 — Request for Donation

Council approved to donate \$500 to the Association for Life-Wide Living in support of the BRAIN Conference being held October 23 to 25, 2026.

Audit Services

Council accepted the proposal from Gitzel & Company for audit services for 2026, for a period of one year.

National Police Federation Call to Action

Council directed administration to reply to the National Police Federation's Call to Action to the Government of Alberta.
